Best Overall Poster

and

People's Pick

Eligibility

The awards are open to anyone who presents a poster in the Poster Presentation section of the *Community Involvement Conference*.

Criteria

The judges of the Best Overall Poster will evaluate each poster based on the following criteria:

- Clarity – coherent and effective message
- Layout and Design – organization and neatness of poster (aesthetic composition)
- Content and Research – engaging and original, well thought out and explored
- Readability – legible from five feet away

Judges

Three Best Overall Poster judges will be chosen by ICMA staff.

The People's Pick award will be chosen by *Community Involvement Conference* attendees. After perusing the poster area during the first day of the conference, each attendee will have the opportunity to cast his/her vote for the People's Pick award. A ballot will be included in conference registration packets that attendees can fill out and place in ballot boxes in the Poster Area.

Prizes and Acknowledgements

Each winner of the Best Overall Poster Award and the People's Pick Award will receive a framed certificate of award. Finally, ICMA will make arrangements to post the award-winning posters on the Community Involvement Conference Website (www.epancic.org/2003) following the conference.

Awards Ceremony

The Awards Ceremony will take place July 24, 2003 at 11am during the Plenary Session.
